As previously discussed at the February House Committee meeting all Post event must be brought before the House Committee for approval by the House Committee.

**Post By-Laws** 

Approved and Dated February 18, 2020

#### Article X Section 4.

Fundraising organizations or individuals conducting solicitation, activities or projects for profit shall not be engaged or used by the Post for such purpose unless such engagement is made by writing agreement between the post and the organization or individual providing those services. The form of any such written agreement must be submitted to the Department (Post) Commander (House Committee) for review at least thirty (30) days prior to any Post entering into any agreement.

#### Section 5.

Unless previously authorized by a majority vote 1<sup>st</sup> the House Committee then the Post, no solicitations or ticket sales shall be permitted in the Post Quarters or at socials or meetings unless such solicitations or ticket sales shall have been approved by the Post.

#### Section 6.

The Ways and Means Committee shall confine any such approved solicitations or ticket sales to the stated meeting and socials of the Post in or around the Post quarters.

Now this is just a procedural thing, this this how we should have been doing this business all along we do not operate as 3 independent organization here. The Post House Committee controls the business and the planning which includes the calendar for the Post. Every event that happens here at 4412 is going to be on the calendar. Nothing will happen if you don't first get your event on the calendar, so come to the House Committee meeting prepared with all your event particles. Band, Basket Raffle, Gun Raffle, Food Drive, Clothing Drive, whatever it might be. All of this goes into the meeting minutes and is read into the Membership meeting minutes for approval by our members. Believe any event is good for the Post so all events get approved, it's about the paperwork and following the proper procedure.
